SECTION-I

1. Introduction about RailTel

RailTel Corporation of India Limited (RailTel), an ISO-9001:2000 organization is a Mini Ratna Government of India undertaking under the Ministry of Railways. The Corporation was formed in Sept 2000 with the objectives to create nationwide Broadband Telecom and Multimedia Network in all parts of the country, to modernize Train Control Operation and Safety System of Indian Railways and to contribute to realization of goals and objective of national telecom policy 1999. RailTel is a wholly owned subsidiary of Indian Railways.

RailTel has approximately 60000 kms of OFC along the protected Railway tracks. The transport network is built on high capacity DWDM and an IP/ MPLS network over it to support mission critical communication requirements of Indian Railways and other customers. RailTel has Tier-III Data Center in Gurgaon and Secunderabad hosting / collocating critical applications. RailTel is also providing Telepresence as a Service (TPaaS), where a High Definition Video Conference facility bundled with required BW is provided as a Service.

5. Response to EOI guidelines

5.1 Language of Proposals

The proposal and all correspondence and documents shall be written in English in soft copy through an email.

5.2 RailTel's Right to Accept/Reject responses

RailTel reserves the right to accept or reject any response and annul the bidding process or even reject all responses at any time prior to selecting the partner, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or Business Associate or without any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders about the grounds for RailTel's action.

5.3 EOI response Document

The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and conditions and technical specifications in the bidding documents. Submission of bids, not substantially responsive to the bidding document in every aspect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of its bid without any further reference to the bidder.

All pages of the documents shall be signed in ink by the bidder including the closing page in token of his having studies the EOI document and should be submitted along with the bid.

5.6 Bid Earnest Money (EMD)

- 5.6.1 The Business Associate shall furnish a sum as given in EOI Notice and Special Conditions Section II via online transferfrom any scheduled bank in India in favour of "RailTel Corporation of India Limited" along with the offer. This will be called as EOI EMD.
- 5.6.2 Offers not accompanied with valid EOI Earnest Money Deposit shall be summarily rejected.
- 5.6.3 Integrity Pact Bank Guarantee as per Special Conditions Section II.
- 5.6.4 **Return of EMD for unsuccessful Business Associates:** EOI EMD of the unsuccessful Business Associate shall be returned without interest after completion of EOI process.
- 5.6.5 Return of EMD for successful Business Associate: EOI-EMD & Earnest Money Deposit (balance proportionate EMD) if applicable and Integrity Pact BG of the successful bidder will be discharged / returned as promptly as possible after the receipt of RailTel's EMD/BG from the Customer and or on receipt of Security Deposit Performance Bank Guarantee as applicable (clause no. 5.7) from BusinessAssociate whichever is later.
- 5.6.6 Forfeiture of EOI EMD or EOI EMD & EMD (balance proportionate EMD) and or Penal action asper EMD Declaration:
 - a) The EOI EMD may be forfeited and or penal action shall be initiated if a Business Associate withdraws his offer or modifies the terms and conditions of the offer during validity period.
 - b) In case of non submission of SD/PBG (as per clause no. 5.7) lead to forfeiture of EOI EMD, EMD (balance proportionate EMD) if applicable and Integrity Pact BG and or suitableaction as prescribed in the EMD Declaration shall be initiated as applicable.

5.7 Security Deposit / Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG)

- 5.7.1 In case the bid is successful, the PBG of requisite amount proportionate to the agreed scope of the work will have to be submitted to RailTel. The amount of the Performance Security shall be: 3%of the total contract Price, Successful Partner to submit within 15 days from the date of Work order is issued, Contract Agreement will be signed post submission of the Performance Security, Performance Security shall be valid 60 days beyond the Warranty period
- 5.7.2 As per work share arrangements agreed between RailTel and Business Associate the PBG will be proportionately decided and submitted by the selected Business Associate.

5.8 Last date & time for Submission of EOI response

EOI response must be submitted to RailTel at the email address specified in the preamble not later than the specified date and time mentioned in the preamble.

5.9 Modification and/or Withdrawal of EOI response

EOI response once submitted will treated, as final and no modification will be permitted. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

No Business Associate shall be allowed to withdraw the response after the last date and time for submission.

The successful Business Associate will not be allowed to withdraw or back out from the response commitments. In case of withdrawal or back out by the successful business associate, the EarnestMoney Deposit shall be forfeited and all interests/claims of such Business Associate shall be deemed as foreclosed.

5.10 Details of Financial bid for the above referred tender

The final bid for the tender will be prepared jointly with the selected Business Associate so that theoptimal bid can be put with a good chance of winning the Tender.

5.11 Clarification of EOI Response

To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids the purchaser may, at its discretion, ask the Business Associate for clarification. The response should be in writing and no change in the price or substance of the EOI response shall be sought, offered or permitted.

8. Evaluation Criteria

- 8.1. The Business Associates are first evaluated on the basis of the Eligibility Criteria asper clause 5 above.
- 8.2. The Business Associate who fulfills the Eligibility criteria of Bidding BA shall be further evaluated on the basis of Technical Evaluation as mentioned in Special Conditions Section II.
- 8.3. Only those bidders who secure more than 70% Score in Technical evaluation will be required to submit financial bid. If there is only one technical bid received and bidder score more than 70% Score in Technical evaluation, than financial bid will be opened and based on same commercial negotiation solution can be worked out to prepare most optimising winnable solutions and then will be invited for exclusive pre-bid arrangement for optimizing technical and commercial solution so that most winnable solution is submitted to end customer..
- 8.4. If more than one bidder fulfills the Eligibility criteria and secure more than 70% Score in Technical evaluation then Bidder shall be selected based on highest score (Quality Cum Cost Based Selection (QCBS)) as per the calculation prescribed in following clause.
- 8.5. Weightage of 70% will be awarded for Technical Evaluation and 30% weightage will be awarded for Financial Evaluation.
- 8.6. Proposal with the lowest cost may be given a financial score of 100 (Hundred) and other proposals given financial scores that are inversely proportional to their prices w.r.t. the lowest offer.
- 8.7. Proposal with the highest technical marks (as allotted by the committee) shall be given a score of 100 (Hundred) and other proposals be given technical score that are proportional to their marks w.r.t. the highest technical marks.

- 8.8. The total score, both technical and financial, shall be obtained by weighing the quality and cost scores and adding them up.
- 8.9. On the basis of the combined weighted score for quality and cost, the Bidder shall be ranked in terms of the total score obtained. The proposal obtaining the highest total combined score in evaluation of quality and cost will be ranked as H-1 followed by the proposals securing lesser marks as H-2, H-3 etc.
- 8.10. The proposal securing the highest combined marks and ranked H1 will be invited for exclusive pre-bid arrangement for optimizing technical and commercial solution so that most winnable solution is submitted to end customer. In the event two or more bids have the same score in final ranking, the bid with highest technical score will be H1.
- 8.11. The bid price will exclude all taxes and levies and shall be in Indian Rupees. Taxes are to mention separately apart from the quoted base price of the proposed components.
- 8.12. Any conditional bid would be rejected.
- 8.13. RailTel reserves the right to accept or reject the response against this EOI, without assigning any reasons. The decision of RailTel is final and binding on the participants. The RailTel evaluation committee will determine whether the proposal/ information is complete in all respects and the decision of the evaluation committee shall be final. RailTel may at its discretion assign lead factor to the Business associate as per RailTel policy for shortlisting partner against this EOI.
- 8.14. All General requirement mentioned in the Technical Specifications are required to be complied. The solution proposed should be robust and scalable.

9 Payment terms

- 9.1 RailTel shall make payment to selected Business Associate after receiving payment from Customer for the agreed scope of work. In case of any penalty or deduction made by customer for the portion of work to be done by BA, same shall be passed on to Business Associate.
