1. Introduction about RailTel

RailTel Corporation of India Limited (RailTel), an ISO-9001:2000 organization is a Nav Ratna Government of India undertaking under the Ministry of Railways. The Corporation wasformed in Sept 2000 with the objectives to create nationwide Broadband Telecom and Multimedia Network in all parts of the country, to modernize Train Control Operation and Safety System of Indian Railways and to contribute to realization of goals and objective of national telecom policy 1999. RailTel is a wholly owned subsidiary of Indian Railways.


RailTel has approximately 61000 kms of OFC along the protected Railway tracks. The transport network is built on high capacity DWDM and an IP/ MPLS network over it to supportmission critical communication requirements of Indian Railways and other customers. RailTelhas Tier-III Data Center in Gurgaon and Secunderabad hosting / collocating critical applications. RailTel is also providing Telepresence as a Service (TPaaS), where a High Definition Video Conference facility bundled with required BW is provided as a Service.

For ensuring efficient administration across India, country has been divided into four regions namely, Eastern, Northern, Southern & Western each headed by Executive Director and Headquartered at Kolkata, New Delhi, Secunderabad & Mumbai respectively. These regions are further divided into territories for efficient working. 2. Project Background and Objective of EOI

RailTel has submitted commercial proposal to end customer and intends to select the execution partner/s if RailTel is awarded the work for providing Skill development, training for end Customer".

RailTel invites EOIs from RailTel's Empaneled Partners for the selection of suitable partner/s for above mentioned work. The empaneled partner is expected to have excellent execution capability and good understanding of the local environment.

3. Scope of Work

Scope of work includes Providing Skill development Training and infrastructure for End Customer".

EOI is being floated for below mentioned work:

- A) Infrastructure/Equipment provider:
 - MIS & Portal Data Managements, Training Infrastructure and Equipment's/Consumables' Items, Printing & Stationary, Study Material and Tool Kits & Over all project monitoring
- B) Mobilization, Publicity and Logistics Provider:
 - Advertisement & Promotion, Orientation and Seminars, Mobilization & Counselling, Logistics & Travelling Expenses, Catering & refreshment.
- C)Faculty and Support staff, Coordination and Placement provider:
 - Accreditations & Affiliation of Training Centre's, Trainers & Supporting Staff, Assessment & Certifications, Placement Facilitation and Post Placement Tracking

In case of any discrepancy or ambiguity in any clause / specification pertaining to scope of work area, the work order released by end customer organization to RailTel as well guidelines provided by end customer shall supersede and will be considered sacrosanct. (All associated clarifications, response to queries, revisions, addendum and corrigendum, associated prime service agreement (PSA)/MSA/SLA also included.) Furthermore, in case if customer negotiates scope of work/commercials at any stage, the back back to back negotiations will be held with selected bidder and any change in the scope of work/commercials shall be passed on proportionately to the selected bidder.

- 1) Bidder can participate only as a sole bidder or as a consortium of maximum two members.
- 2) Sole bidder/Lead bidder in case of consortium will be responsible for all the conditions mentioned in the end customer scope of work along with submission of EMD/PBG. Work order shall be issued to Lead bidder of consortium if consortium gets selected for the execution of the work, if RailTel is awarded the work.
- 3) Each consortium partner shall be jointly and severally responsible for completing the task as per the contract. RailTel, in any case, will deal with the lead partner, who shall be responsible for execution of work and shall be entitled to receive payments as per payment terms
- 4) Sole bidder/Consortium members can only apply for only one scope of work mentioned in this EOI. In case if sole bidder/any consortium member applies for more than one scope of work, only one bid will be accepted for any of the scope of work mentioned above.

- 5) The bid to be signed by all members of the consortium. Alternatively, the lead bidder may sign the bid. In such a case, the Authorization Letter/ Board Resolution from each member authorizing the leader for signing and submission of bid on behalf of individual member must accompany the bid offer. The formation of consortium or change in the consortium character/partners after submission of the bid and any change in the bidding regarding consortium will not be permitted.
- 6) The consortium agreement must specifically state that it is valid for the project for which bidding is done. If consortium breaks up midway before award of work and during bid validity period, bid will be rejected. If consortium breaks up midway before award of work and during bid validity/after award of work/during pendency of contract, in addition to normal penalties as per provision of tender document, all the partners of the consortium shall be debarred from participating in future bids for a minimum period of twelve (12) months or maximum 36 months as per decision of RailTel.

Special Note: RailTel may retain any portion of the work mentioned in the end organization RFP, where RailTel has competence so that overall proposal becomes most economically viable proposal.

4. Response to EOI guidelines

4.1Language of Proposals

The proposal and all correspondence and documents shall be written in English in soft copy through an email.

4.2 RailTel's Right to Accept/Reject responses

RailTel reserves the right to accept or reject any response and annul the bidding process or even reject all responses at any time prior to selecting the partner, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or empaneled partner or without any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders about the grounds for RailTel's action.

4.3 EOI response Document

The bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and conditions and technical specifications in the bidding documents. Submission of bids, not substantially responsive to the bidding document in every aspect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in rejection of its bid without any further reference to the bidder.

All pages of the documents shall be signed by the bidder's authorized person including the closing page in token of his having studied the EOI document and should be submitted along with the bid.

4.4 Period of Validity of bids and Bid Currency

Bids shall remain valid for a period of 120 days from the date of submission bid

4.5 Bid Earnest Money (EMD)

4.5.1 Bidder shall furnish a sum as given in EOI Notice via online transfer from any scheduled bank in India in favour of "RailTel Corporation of India Limited" along with the offer. This will be called as EOI EMD.

- 4.5.2 Offers not accompanied with valid EOI Fees and EOI EMD shall be summarily rejected.
- 4.5.3 The selected Bidder shall have to submit a Bank Guarantee against EMD in proportion to the quoted value/scope of work to RailTel.
- 4.5.4 Return of EMD for unsuccessful Bidder: EOI EMD of the unsuccessful bidder shall be returned without interest after completion of EOI process/Completion of end customer process whichever is later.
- 4.5.5 Return of EMD for successful Bidder: EOI-EMD & Earnest Money Deposit if applicable of the successful bidder will be discharged / returned as promptly as possible after the receipt of RailTel's EMD/BG from the Customer and or on receipt of Security Deposit Performance Bank Guarantee as applicable (clause no. 3.7) from bidder whichever is later.
- 4.5.6 Forfeiture of EOI EMD or EOI EMD and or Penal action asper EMD Declaration:
 - a) The EOI EMD may be forfeited and or penal action shall be initiated if bidder withdraws his offer or modifies the terms and conditions of the offer during validity period.
 - b) In case of non-submission of SD/PBG (as per clause no. 3.7) lead to forfeiture of EOI EMD, EMD (balance proportionate EMD) if applicable and or suitable action as prescribed in the EMD Declaration shall be initiated as applicable

4.6 Security Deposit / Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG)

- 4.6.1 In case the bidder is successful, the PBG of requisite amount proportionate to the agreed scope of the work will have to be submitted to RailTel. If required PBG amount is less than Rs. 5 Lakh, then PBG shall be paid in online cash transfer/DD by successful bidder within fifteen days of issue of LOI.
- 4.6.2 As per work share arrangements agreed between RailTel and bidder the PBG will be proportionately decided and submitted by the selected bidder/s

4.7 Last date & time for Submission of EOI response

EOI response must be submitted to RailTel at the email address specified in the preamble not later than the specified date and time mentioned in the preamble.

4.8 Modification and/or Withdrawal of EOI response

EOI response once submitted will treated, as final and no modification will be permitted except with the consent of the RailTel.

No bidder shall be allowed to withdraw the response after the last date and time for submission.

The successful Bidder will not be allowed to withdraw or back out from the response commitments. In case of withdrawal or back out by the successful Bidder, the Earnest Money Deposit shall be forfeited, and all interests/claims of such Bidder shall be deemed as foreclosed.

4.9 Details of Financial bid for the above referred tender

Bidder meeting eligibility criteria with lowest quoted price/revenue share will be selected for execution of work if RailTel is awarded the work.

4.10 Clarification of EOI Response

To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids the purchaser may, at its discretion, ask the Bidder for clarification/additional documents. The response should be in writing and no change in the price or substance of the EOI response shall be sought, offered or permitted.

4.11 Other terms and conditions

- 1) In case of any discrepancy, terms and conditions mentioned in the end customer work order to RailTel shall prevail
- 2) Bidder shall be responsible for the scope of work its selected for. Any penalty against the non-performance/SLA shall be borne by the bidder.
- 3) Successful bidder has to adhere to the execution timelines mentioned in the end customer work order
- 4) RailTel shall sign definitive agreement with bidder/consortium in case RailTel's commercials are successful and RailTel is awarded the work.
- 5) Variation in Quantity: Quantity may vary by +/- (increased or decreased) by 50%.

In that case, the written notice can be modified by RailTel as deemed fit under the circumstances. RailTel may either decide to issue a termination notice or to continue the agreement by suitable modifying the conditions, as it feels fit under the circumstances.

18. Governing Laws

The contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of India. The courts at New Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction to entertain and try all matters arising out of this contract.

19. Statutory Compliance

- 19.1. During the tenure of this Contract nothing shall be done by SELECTED BIDDER in contravention of any law, act and/ or rules/regulations, there under or any amendment thereof and shall keep RailTel indemnified in this regard.
- 19.2. The Bidder shall comply and ensure strict compliance by his/her employees and agents of all applicable Central, State, Municipal and Local laws and Regulations and undertake to indemnify RailTel, from and against all levies, damages, penalties and payments whatsoever as may be imposed by reason of any breach or violation of any law, rule, including but not limited to the claims against RailTel or its Customer under Employees Compensation Act, 1923, The Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952, The Contract Labour (Abolition and Regulation) Act 1970, Factories Act, 1948, Minimum Wages Act and Regulations, Shop and Establishment Act and Labour Laws which would be amended/modified or any new act if it comes in force whatsoever, and all actions claim and demand arising there from and/or related thereto.

20. Intellectual Property Rights

- 20.1. Each party i.e. RailTel and SELECTED BIDDER, acknowledges and agree that the other party retains exclusive ownership and rights in its trade secrets, inventions, copyrights, and other intellectual property and any hardware provided by such party in relation to this contract / agreement.

21. Severability

23. Indemnity

24.5. This Confidentiality and Non-disclosure clause shall survive even after the expiry or termination of this contract.

- (iv) is disclosed in response to a valid order of a court or other governmental body in the India or any political subdivision thereof, but only to the extent of, and for the purposes set forth in, such order; provided, however, that Receiving Party shall first and immediately notify Disclosing Party in writing of the order and permit Disclosing Party to seek an appropriate protective order.
- (c) Both parties further agree to exercise the same degree of care that it exercises to protect its own Confidential Information of a like nature from unauthorised disclosure, but in no event shall a less than reasonable degree of care be exercised by either party.

2. Designation.

- (a) Information shall be deemed confidential and proprietary and subject to the restrictions of this Agreement if, when provided in:
- (i) written or other tangible form, such Information is clearly marked as proprietary or confidential when disclosed to Receiving Party; or
- (ii) oral or other intangible form, such Information is identified as confidential or proprietary at the time of disclosure.
- **3.** <u>Cooperation.</u> Receiving Party will immediately give notice to Disclosing Party of any unauthorized use or disclosure of the Information of Disclosing Party.
- 4. Ownership of Information. All Information remains the property of Disclosing Party and no license or other rights to such Information is granted or implied hereby. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Disclosing Party understands that Receiving Party may currently or in the future be developing information internally, or receiving information from other parties that may be similar to Information of the Disclosing Party. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, nothing in this Agreement will be construed as a representation or inference that Receiving Party will not develop products, or have products developed for it, that, without violation of this Agreement, compete with the products or systems contemplated by Disclosing Party's Information.
- 5. <u>No Obligation</u>. Neither this Agreement nor the disclosure or receipt of Information hereunder shall be construed as creating any obligation of a Party to furnish Information to the other Party or to enter into any agreement, venture or relationship with the other Party.

6. Return or Destruction of Information.

- (a) All Information shall remain the sole property of Disclosing Party and all materials containing any such Information (including all copies made by Receiving Party) and its Representatives shall be returned or destroyed by Receiving Party immediately upon the earlier of:
 - (i) termination of this Agreement;
 - (ii) expiration of this Agreement; or

- (iii) Receiving Party's determination that it no longer has a need for such Information.
- (b) Upon request of Disclosing Party, Receiving Party shall certify in writing that all Information received by Receiving Party (including all copies thereof) and all materials containing such Information (including all copies thereof) have been destroyed.
- 7. Injunctive Relief: Without prejudice to any other rights or remedies that a party may have, each party acknowledges and agrees that damages alone may not be an adequate remedy for any breach of this Agreement, and that a party shall be entitled to seek the remedies of injunction, specific performance and/or any other equitable relief for any threatened or actual breach of this Agreement

9. Term, Termination and Survivability.

13. Settlement of Disputes:

- a) The parties shall, at the first instance, attempt to resolve through good faith negotiation and consultation, any difference, conflict or question arising between the parties hereto relating to or concerning or arising out of or in connection with this agreement, and such negotiation or consultation shall begin promptly after a Party has delivered to another Party a written request for such consultation.
- b) In the event of any dispute, difference, conflict or question arising between the parties hereto, relating to or concerning or arising out of or in connection with this agreement, is not settled through good faith negotiation or consultation, the same shall be referred to arbitration by a sole arbitrator.
- c) The sole arbitrator shall be appointed by CMD/RailTel out of the panel of independent arbitrators maintained by RailTel, having expertise in their respective domains. The seat and the venue of arbitration shall be New Delhi. The arbitration proceedings shall be in accordance with the provision of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 and any other statutory amendments or modifications thereof. The decision of arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties. The arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English Language. The fees and cost of arbitration shall be borne equally between the parties.

14. CONFIDENTIALITY OF NEGOTIATIONS

Without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent, the Receiving Party shall not disclose to any Person who is not a Representative of the Receiving Party the fact that Confidential Information has been made available to the Receiving Party or that it has inspected any portion of the Confidential Information or that discussions between the Parties may be taking place.

15. REPRESENTATION

The Receiving Party acknowledges that the Disclosing Party makes no representation or warranty as to the accuracy or completeness of any of the Confidential Information furnished by or on its behalf. Nothing in this clause operates to limit or exclude any liability for fraudulent misrepresentation.

16. ASSIGNMENT

Neither this Agreement nor any of the rights, interests or obligations under this Agreement shall be assigned, in whole or in part, by operation of law or otherwise by any of the Parties without the prior written consent of each of the other Parties. Any purported assignment without such consent shall be void. Subject to the preceding sentences, this Agreement will be binding upon, inure to the benefit of, and be enforceable by, the Parties and their respective successors and assigns.

17. EMPLOYEES AND OTHERS
